



Saltoluokta – Guided Day trip Stora Sjöfallet

On this historical hike in the Laponia mountains we travel to Stora Sjöfallet National Park. Stora Sjöfallet was once one of Europe’s largest waterfalls. By boat we travel on one of the Swedish Lapland most beautiful lakes, hike through ancient pine forests and discover the waterfall that was once described as “The Niagara Falls of Scandinavia”. We end by cooking lunch over an open fire and making coffee in the traditional way.

Date	Every Saturday during the period 18/6-17/9 2022, Wednesday (and Saturday) 20/7-20/8 2022.
Venue	STF Saltoluokta mountain station
First gathering (time/place)	We gather down at the pier M/S Langas. Check with the reception for departure time.
Finale (time/place)	Early afternoon (approximately 2.30pm), at the pier Saltoluokta mountain station.

Number of participants	Minimum 4 participants. The tour may be cancelled in case of too few bookings or in case of low water level or severe weather.
Minimum age	The child should be able to walk alone at the adult's pace for about 4km or sit in a baby carrier/backpack.
For whom?	For you who wants to learn more of the nature and cultural history of the world heritage Lapponia
Experience	No previous experience required. Able to hike about 4km at a leisurely pace in mountain terrain.

About the area

Saltoluokta mountain station is located on the border of the large national parks Stora Sjöfallet/Stour Mourkke, Sarek and UNESCO world heritage Laponia. Here are fantastic conditions for new discoveries in old pine- and birch forest and for nice trips in the Swedish mountains.

Our facility and events actively work not to expose nature to wear and tear. We also work closely with local suppliers and consider to the specific conditions in the area.

Dogs are not allowed on our guided events, but most welcome to the mountains station if you want to make your own trip to Saltoluokta.

Saltoluokta mountain station was built in 1912 and the current main building is a timbered wooden building from 1918. Even today, we use some of the original furniture in the dining room and living room and we let open fires warm and spread the good atmosphere in the house.

We have Wi-Fi, which you can happily use – although it is not the fastest!
There is decent mobile coverage in the area.

Getting here

We recommend environment friendly travel. There are daily departures from Stockholm/Gothenburg by train to Gällivare. In Gällivare there is a connecting bus 93 to Kebnats (Saltoluokta at the road). We schedule our departures by boat in the summer and snow mobile in the winter to match the connecting bus from Gällivare/Ritsem. We advise you to book your bus and train ticket together, as you then have travel guarantee if bus/train is delayed. Further information how to get to Saltoluokta can be read [here](#).
